

## FROM CHESTER / FROM A51

Follow A51, A54 and A556 to Rudheath (19.8 miles).

At the roundabout: take the **first exit on to the A530 Stoke-on-Trent, this is King Street**. Follow this road for 2.6 miles (4.2km). The site entrance follows the S.G.S.P sign on your left.

## FROM M56

Follow M56 to Warrington. Take exit 10 from M56 (17.3 miles)

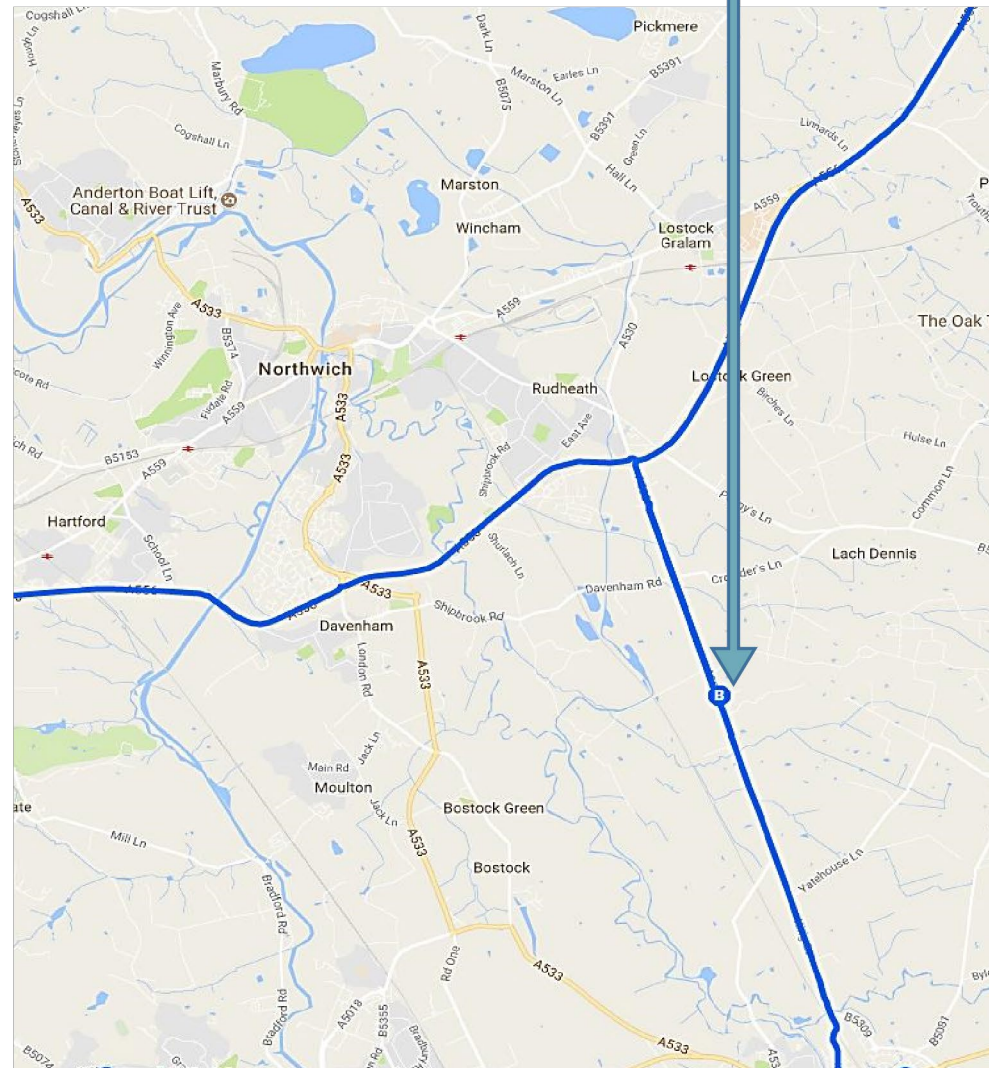
At junction 10, take the A49 exit to Warrington/Northwich  
Follow A559 and A530 to your destination. (9.9 miles) The site entrance follows the SGSP sign on your left.

## FROM MIDDLEWICH/SOUTH

Leave the M6 at J18  
Follow signs for the A54 Middlewich

At the roundabout, take the third exit onto B5309. Turn right onto King Street/ B5309 (1.1 miles)

Continue onto A530 for 1 mile and turn right when you see the S.G.S.P or Storengy sign.



## FROM THE AIRPORT / NORTH

### FROM AIRPORT

Follow the signs for the **M56**. At junction 7, merge on to the **A556, Birmingham, M6, Northwich, Lymm**. Stay on this road for 4 miles (6.4km).

Then

### FROM THE JUNCTION 19

At Tabley Interchange (J19), follow A556 to **Northwich/Macclesfield**. Follow this road for 5.1 miles (8.2km).

At the roundabout: **first exit on to the A530 Stoke-on-Trent, this is King Street**. Follow this road for 2.6 miles (4.2km). The site entrance follows the S.G.S.P sign on your left.
